### 1. Sriracha

Huy Fong Foods, Irvdale, CA, USA

Aka cock sauce, the cult sauce from LA was created by a jobless and hot-sauce-less David Tran in 1980. The company now produces 20 million bottles a year. The red bottle and green cap is meant to resemble a chilli.

### 2. Hoisin

Lee Kum Kee, Hong Kong

Aka tuong den, hoisin (Chinese for seafood); this dark, sweet and salty condiment is the go-to accompaniment for southern-style pho.

### 3. Kikkoman Soy Sauce

Kikkoman Corporation, Singapore

Formed in 1917, Kikko-man means tortoise (kikko) and 10,000 years (man) to symbolise longevity. The naturally brewed sauce is the most popular soy sauce in Japan and the USA. Additionally, the iconic bottle was designed by Kenji Ekuian in 1961 – who is also responsible for the E3 Series Shinkansen (bullet train).

### 4. Chilli Oil

Made: Phamily Kitchen, right here!
